Mountainside Library 3D Printer Policy

The Library's 3D Printer is available for making three-dimensional plastic objects using a design that is uploaded from a digital computer file. All Mountainside computer and network policies apply to the use of the 3D Printer.

- The Library's 3D printer may be used only for lawful purposes. It is the responsibility of the patron to verify the eligibility of the item to be printed. The public will not be permitted to use the printer to create material that is:
 - Prohibited by local, state, or federal law.
 - Unsafe, harmful, dangerous or poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others.
 - Obscene or otherwise inappropriate for the library environment.
 - o In violation of another's intellectual property rights. Printers will not be used to reproduce material that is subject to copyright, patent, or trademark protection.
 - The printing of a weapon of any sort, including, but not limited to, a blade or firearm, any part of a weapon, or any item intended to be used as a weapon is strictly prohibited.
- Mountainside Library reserves the right to refuse any 3D print request.
- The minimum cost per print is \$3.00. There will be an additional charge of \$.05 per gram for items weighing over 20 grams.
- Items that are not picked up within 7 days will become the property of the Mountainside Library.
- Print time is limited to 5 hours.
- Print times are subject to library hours and staff availability. Print jobs cannot be run while the library is closed.
